Monday, April 25, 2011, forms and full payment were due.

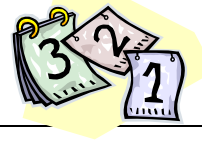
New scouts that joined Troop 26 in 2011 have until Monday, June 13th for full payment.

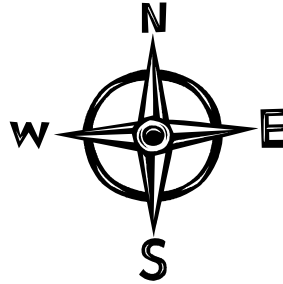

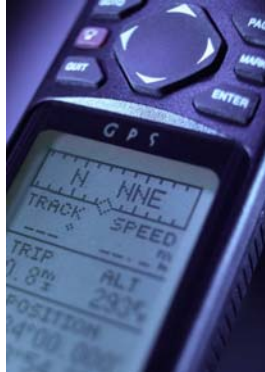
