### The World Famous Troop 26 Pumpkin Dump Cake

1 can (15 oz.) solid-pack pumpkin  
1 can (12 OZ.) evaporated milk  
3 eggs  
1 cup sugar  
4 teaspoons pumpkin pie spices  
1 package yellow cake mix  
3/4 cup butter, melted  
1 1/2 cups chopped walnuts  
Ice cream, or whipped topping

In mixing bowl dump the first 5 ingredients. Dump that mixture into greased Dutch oven (or 9"X12" pan). Dump (sprinkle) with the dry cake mix. Dump (drizzle) the butter on top. Dump (sprinkle again) on the walnuts. Bake for about 1 hour in hot Dutch oven with coals on the top and bottom. (Or bake in oven at 350 degrees for about an hour). Serve with whipped topping if camping. Enjoy! (Dump into the tummy?)
